

When Skies are Grey Baby Quilt Pattern

Materials:

1 ¼ yards of When Skies are Grey Main Panel

1 yard for border fabric--black swiss dot

½ yard for binding fabric--white with gold stars

2 ½ yards for backing (or 1 ¼ yards of wide back fabric)

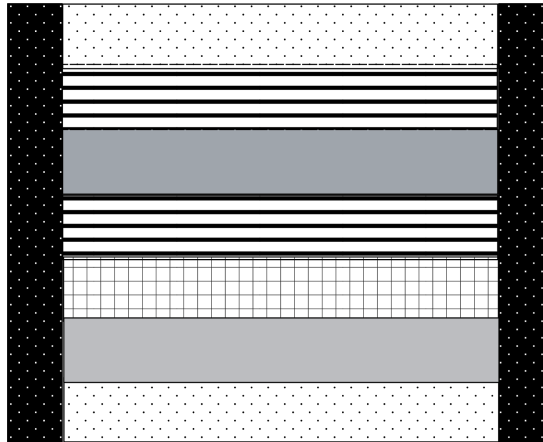
Cutting Directions:

*Cut six 5" by wof fabric strips of border fabric

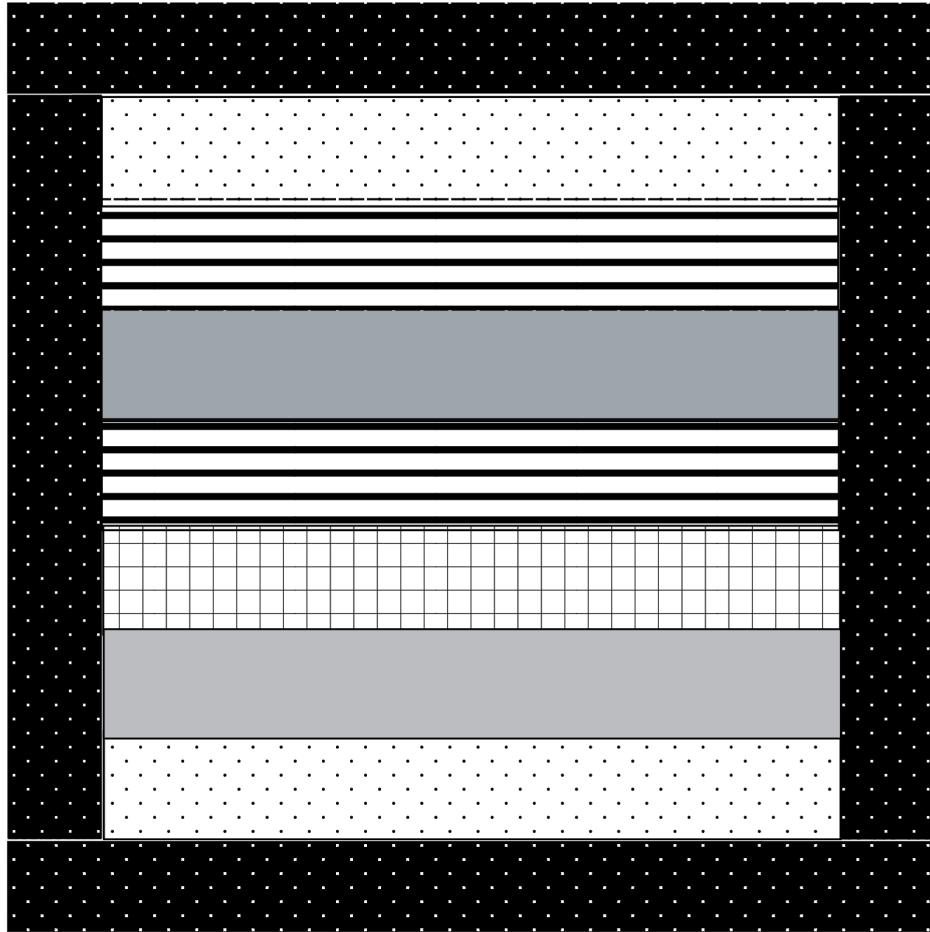
*Cut six 2.5" by wof fabric strips of binding fabric

Directions:

1. Cut two of your 5" by wof strips in half (22" in length). You will have 4 pieces 22" by 5."
2. Sew these four strips you cut in step #1 to each of the remaining 5" by wof strips. Press seams to one side.
3. Take your 44" by 44" piece of main fabric and press well.
4. Add 2 of the border strips created in steps #1 and #2 to the left and right of your 44" by 44" main fabric piece. Trim to the main fabric piece. Press.



5. Then add the other two long border strips to the top and bottom of the quilt panel. Press and trim.



6. Baste and quilt as desired. Square up your quilt as needed.
7. Now it's time to make your binding. Use your (6) 2.5" binding strips and stitch them together to create one long continuous piece of binding. If you need help making binding refer to [THIS TUTORIAL](#).
8. Fold binding in half and press.
9. Sew the raw edges of binding the raw edges of the wrong side of your quilt. Miter corners. (See [THIS TUTORIAL](#) for help.) Then turn binding over and top stitch on the top of the quilt.
